ADMISSIONS POLICY

The responsibility for the administration of admission of learners to public schools has been delegated by the Head of Department to the principal of this school. The admissions committee comprises of the Principal, SGB Chairperson, Admin Clerk and SMT.

Access to the school: No learner will be denied access on the basis of race, religion, colour, language or culture.

Age of learners: Where a child is 3 years or over the normal grade age, the SMT and SGB must decide whether to admit the learner to an appropriate grade in the school. Such a learner will not be denied admission.



Age norms: Grade R: Learner must turn 5 years by 30 June on the year of admission Grade 1: Learner must turn 6 years by 30 June on the year of admission Underage learners will not be admitted to school. On the year of admission

Admission Tests: No tests will be set to admit learners.

Fees: On applying for admission for a new academic year, the first instalment of school fees is due. This amount will be determined each year at the annual budget meeting. Parents qualifying for exemption will apply for same.

Feeder areas: All applications will be accepted on a first come first basis.

Readmission: A learner who wishes to remain in this school for the next year must apply for admission before the end of the current school year.

Documents to be produced on registration: Learner's birth certificate or a sworn affidavit about the age of a learner, clinic card, transfer card, last school report, parent's identification, study permit for foreign students and a temporary or permanent residence permit or evidence thereof(Foreigner) [Refer to circular 1 of 2019 and 58 of 2019]. The application form must be filled in completely and signed. Failure to produce a birth certificate will result in the matter being referred to the HOD and the HOD will hold the parents accountable to acquire a birth certificate [Refer to the Govt. Gazette No. 44139, dated 10 February 2021]. On admission, transfer learners must produce a transfer card.

Admissions will be refused if: Documents have been forged or altered. The learner is not accompanied by a parent or guardian.

If the principal refuses admission, he must keep a written record of the reasons.
